- **b)** you act as a representative of, or attorney for, the Supplier, including for the Supplier that is not a natural person ("**Representative**") or
- c) you are a contact person of the Supplier, including the Supplier that is not a natural person, or you are a person authorised on the part of the Supplier to make arrangements in the course of executing or performing the contract(s) ("Contact Person").

	As the <b>Supplier, Representative or Contact Person,</b> you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority competent for personal data protection if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the GDPR.
Right to object	<ul> <li>If you are the Supplier, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data for the purpose of pursuing one or more of our legitimate interests, which are:</li> <li>pre-qualification before entering into a contractual relationship</li> <li>establishing, exercising or defending legal claims.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If you are the Supplier's Representative or Contact Person, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data for the purpose of pursuing one or more of our legitimate interests, which are:</li> <li>entering into and performance of the Contract concluded with the Supplier of which you are the Representative or Contact Person;</li> <li>establishing, exercising or defending legal claims.</li> </ul>
	The reason for the objection must be your particular situation. After we have received your objection, we will stop processing your data for the purpose or purposes to which you have objected, unless we demonstrate that there are compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms or grounds for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.
